



Dear Parent / Carer,

I am writing to you with important information about the last few weeks of Year 11 and further information regarding how our students will be awarded and will receive grades this summer.

Leaving Date & Prom

Students will 'leave' on Friday 28th May, as part of the leaving celebrations we have organised a leavers breakfast assembly on that day – further details are in the timeline of events below.

We are committed to running a prom to mark the end of students time at Scalby. A date in September has been set aside, this will hopefully allow students to celebrate together free from COVID-19 restrictions. The ability to run this event will depend on student demand and any national developments related to COVID-19. Mr Hutton will be working with students over the next 3 weeks to find out students appetite for this event.

After half-term some students may need to return to school to complete any missing assessments. Mr Hutton and Mr Davis will contact students and parents where this is the case. Following completion of all GCSE assessments students will be provided with tasks via Google Classroom that will support them with their studies and progression onto the next stage in their education. Students will be encouraged to engage in these activities at home in order to support their educational progression. These will be available for students to access until the end of June.

Final Summer Assessments

Our key focus over the next 3 weeks is strengthening the evidence base, and therefore Year 11 students will be sitting final assessments in most of their subjects. As previously mentioned, these assessments will only form part of the evidence

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base. Assessments will fully reflect and be appropriate to what students have been taught with regards to knowledge and skills. Students will be fully informed in lessons about the nature of the assessments and will be given the opportunity to revise for them. Please encourage your son/daughter to prepare properly for these assessments and ensure that they have 100% attendance over the next 3 weeks. As always, high levels of conduct, punctuality and appearance are an expectation from all students during the remaining time at school.
